

Club Advised Funds

Clubs may invest their charitable funds in the investment pool of the Foundation as a Club Advised Fund or sub fund. This allows the Club Advised Fund to receive tax deductible donations under the 501(c)(3) IRS provisions of the Foundation. The minimum amount in a Club Advised Fund is \$5,000. The club may distribute funds for their charitable projects at any time upon approval of the Foundation board. The club pays an annual administrative fee to the Foundation and investment management fees to the Investment Advisor. Contact the Foundation at CAF@odkf.org for more details.

Investments

Funds entrusted to the Ohio District Kiwanis Foundation are invested under the guidelines of the Investment Policy adopted by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors has contracted with Raymond James to manage the investment of funds. The Board carefully monitors investment performance against industry benchmarks.

How Can I Contribute to the Foundation?

Ambassadors of the Foundation

Ambassadors are those Ohio District Kiwanis members who provide continuing financial donations. A minimum donation is \$50. Recognition is given as the gifts increase to total amounts of \$100, \$500, \$1,000 and more. Special medallions and plaques are presented for the Past International Presidents Award and the Penn, Williams, Sellers and Schneider Awards.

Legion of Honor Society

The Legion of Honor Society recognizes Kiwanis members who have achieved 25 or more years of service. Donations of \$5 per year of service are recognized with a certificate and an honor pin.

Safe and Healthy Kids Fund

Donations provide grants for Kiwanis club projects for our Kiwanis Safe and Healthy Kids program.

Endowment Society

The Endowment Society recognizes those individuals who include the Ohio District Kiwanis Foundation in their estate planning.

How Your Donations Are Used by Your Foundation

The Ohio Kiwanis District Foundation is committed to perpetuating the excellent service projects throughout the Ohio Kiwanis District by providing annual grants to K Family clubs. During the past 40 years we have distributed over \$1,750,000. Donations to the Foundation enable us to continue to support Kiwanis Clubs which focus on our Kiwanis Safe and Healthy Kids program or community improvement projects.

Regular Grants and Mini Grants

The Foundation Board approves two types of grants.

1) General grants are those that support our Safe and Healthy Kids program or community improvement programs. These grants are up to \$3000. These grants are given three times per Kiwanis administrative year. The application deadlines are November 30, March 31, and June 30.

2) Mini grants are awarded to clubs six times per administrative year. These grants are up to \$500 and require a match by the local club. Grant deadlines are October 31, December 31, February 28, April 30, June 30, August 31.
